

# NOTICE OF COVID-19 HEALTH SCREENING AND OTHER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

San Manuel Band of Mission Indians (the “Tribe”) holds health and safety as a core value and guiding principle. We have implemented a number of new safety measures to limit the spread of COVID-19. Please heed all announcements and directives from our team members and follow all posted instructions and guidance at the Tribal Court Building, including the following:

- Stay home if you are sick
- Submit to an entrance health screening, including a temperature check, prior to entry
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer when washing is not practical
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from persons not in your household
- Wear a disposable or cloth face covering that fits well and covers your mouth and nose upon approaching and while on the property

## **COVID-19 AND POTENTIAL COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION WARNINGS**

Despite enhanced health and safety measures adopted by the Tribe, there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any location where multiple people are present. COVID-19 is highly contagious and can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.

By visiting San Manuel Tribal Court you voluntarily assume the risks related to potential exposure to COVID-19 while at the property.

In an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19, please be aware that you will be subject to screening questions and a temperature check prior to entry, and the response to such questions and/or your temperature result may result in denial of entry. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher or who otherwise fails to pass the health screening will be denied entrance to the property. Failure to pass the health screening may be reported to security and health officials and your consent to screening is deemed consent to such reporting.
