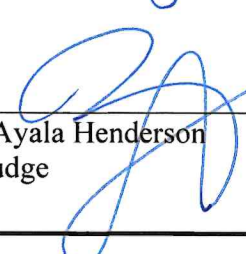
Rule 1.3 of the San Manuel Tribal Court Rules of Court promotes the just, efficient, and orderly administration of justice. To that end, a uniform filing deadline will assist the Court and parties in the fair and efficient resolution of matters before the court.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All pleadings, motions, briefs, declarations, exhibits, and other documents intended for consideration at a scheduled hearing shall be filed no later than five (5) business days before the scheduled hearing date. Timely filed documents will be considered by the Court for the scheduled hearing.
2. Parties should not expect documents filed outside the five (5) business day filing period to be reviewed or considered at the scheduled hearing absent good cause or further order of the Court.
3. Documents filed fewer than five (5) business days before a scheduled hearing may be accepted for filing but are not required to be considered by the Court at that hearing. The Court retains discretion to consider or decline late-filed materials and may shorten or extend time requirements when the interests of justice so require.
4. *Ex parte* matters are exempt and shall be addressed on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the assigned judicial officer.
5. This Order shall take effect on August 20, 2026, and apply to all hearings scheduled thereafter.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
